FRIDAY: How did we end up here?

Do you think you are well-off, average or financially disadvantaged?

Why do you think people end up in poverty?

What can we do to help that person out of poverty?



Some tips to think about and keep the conversation going:

- Being in poverty is nothing to be ashamed of! There are lots of reasons a person might fall into poverty including family violence, illness/ injuries or natural disasters.
- Poverty is actually quite common in Australia. Over three million Australians live in poverty. That includes 774,000 children – or one in every six children.*
- Sometimes people can be struggling, but we cannot always see it. Why do you think people might hide being in poverty?
- What do you think we can do as a country to protect people from falling into poverty?
